There are many of Our Lady's messages in which She speaks of blessing and emphasizes the power of blessing. Also, in the message of July 18, 1985, Our Lady tells us: "Today I call you to place more blessed objects in your homes and that everyone put some blessed objects on their person. Bless all the objects and thus Satan will attack you less because you will have armor against him." On the feast of the Assumption in 1985, She said: "Today I am blessing you and I wish to tell you that I love you and that I urge you to live my messages. Today I am blessing you with the solemn blessing that the Almighty grants me."

The Church teaches us how "God, from whom every blessing comes," allows us to bless people in His name and to shower God's blessings on creatures. When you bless others, you become able to receive blessings yourself. In Peter's first letter we read: "Do not return evil for evil, or insult for insult; but, on the contrary, a blessing, because to this you were called, that you might inherit a blessing." (1 Peter 3:9)

Out of human nature, we envy, speak ill of, even curse those who have successful lives and wealth. People are envious and find it difficult to bless those who have achieved something in life, who have been successful.

Instead, they bow down to criticize and speak ill of them. If God has bestowed visible good on someone, be generous and give thanks for God's goodness, for your brother, so that your eye may not envy. If you see someone who is blessed by God's power, bless him and the blessing will come into your life as well. This is God's promise.

Bless your life circumstances even when they are totally different from your plans and desires. Bless them to change for the good, because it is by what you think, say and expect about people that you change them.

How many gifts, unfortunately, have remained undiscovered because there has been nobody to support and encourage them. How many talents have not been realized because perhaps the parents, with their negative prognoses, have killed in the child the will to live.

We often hear the expressions "you will never become anything" or "you don't know anything" or "you are good for nothing". These words begin to act as a curse that kills the will to live and to realize

all that is good and noble that is hidden in children as a treasure.

If we nourish people with hope, faith, love, trust, they will thrive. Let us expect and encourage the best, and the best will happen in our lives. To nourish ourselves and others with blessings and positive thoughts and words is to bring to life the treasure that we are and that we carry within us.

From the Gospel of Luke we know the blessing of Zechariah: "Blessed be the Lord, the God of Israel, for he has visited and brought redemption to his people..." St. Paul begins his magnificent hymn in the letter to the Ephesians with the words: "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavens" (Ephesians 1:3). Jesus teaches us how to bless: "Bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you" (Luke 6:28). If we want good for ourselves, then let us listen to these words of Jesus. The blessing protects us from every attack of evil forces that are powerless before God's blessing and will retreat. The important thing is not to allow them to enter, and in this the power of the blessing protects us.

Let us pray: Blessed Mother of Jesus, when you met Elizabeth, a hymn of praise burst from your heart in which you glorified and praised the Lord God. You yourself felt loved and blessed, therefore you were able to speak in this way, because your words came from a heart touched by the Lord's grace. I beseech you in a special way, Blessed Mother, to grant us the experience of blessing and love so that we ourselves may bless other people, circumstances and life situations. Bless us with your motherly blessing so that all negative words, thoughts, desires and pessimism may disappear from our hearts. Through our pure speech and words, may God come into our hearts and our families and fill us with the fullness of His blessing and peace. Amen.

Be an Expression of Heaven on Earth

Peace is a Person - Jesus Christ. It was at Christmas in 2012 when, according to the testimony of the visionary Maria Lunetti, the Child Jesus spoke for the first time during an apparition from the arms of the Virgin Mary. He said: "I am your peace, live my commandments".

Jesus' peace is not of this world. He tells us that we can obtain it by keeping the commandments. He laid down His life for the greatest commandment He gave us: "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength.' The second is this: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no other commandment greater than these." (Mark 12:30-31)

Jesus and his friends, the saints, die out of love for this commandment. This is Jesus' way of peace.

We all long for peace and seek it. In fact, everything a person does, he does in order to be well, to be content. But the peace that this world offers is short-lived, it will quickly fade away. The powerful of this world want others to die for them, to be well and have peace. Jesus shows us another way, in human terms it looks like He loses, but in the end, it is always He who is the only winner. Love has the last word. Restlessness arises when we are unable to die for others, to accept them as they are, the situation as it is. From small disturbances, conflicts, big ones arise and can escalate to war. Mary gives us a simple advice - return to prayer.

Jesus was constantly in prayer with the Father; when things were difficult He prayed more. You are who you are with it is said and also that everyone prays as he or she lives, because everyone lives as he or she prays.

"The fruit of prayer is faith, the fruit of faith is love, the fruit of love is service, and the fruit of service is peace", said Mother Teresa.

There is one well-known incident from her life. Her fellow sisters were increasingly busy caring for the poor on the streets of Calcutta. It required more and more time until it interfered with the daily schedule the sisters had at the convent. They were thinking how to



adjust the schedule to leave more time for the poor. They wanted to shorten the time of daily adoration. But instead of shortening the prayer time, Mother Teresa lengthened it by an hour. Again, peace returned, and there was enough time for everything. Mother Teresa knew that when the demands of the service increased, it was necessary to pray more. The fruit of faith is a specific love that brings peace.

The Queen of Peace is calling us: "Return to prayer", and this is the answer to the solution to the turmoil. She said: "My children, there is no peace where there is no prayer and there is no love where there is no faith; In prayer you will receive the answer to all our whys and every pain, cross, darkness will be transformed into light; My motherly heart longs for your heart to be open to say to it: "Believe!"; My children, faith is the only thing that will give you strength in the trials of life. It will renew your soul and open the paths of hope. I am with you. I gather you around me because I want to help you so that you can help your neighbors in discovering faith, the only joy and happiness of life."

Let us pray: *Prayer of St. Francis of Assisi (Prayer for Peace)*: Lord, make me an instrument of your peace: where there is hatred, let me sow love; where there is injury, pardon; where there is doubt, faith; where there is despair, hope; where there is darkness, light; where there is sadness, joy. O divine Master, grant that I may not so much seek to be consoled as to console, to be understood as to understand, to be loved as to love. For it is in giving that we receive, it is in pardoning that we are pardoned, and it is in dying that we are born to eternallife.

1 Have Killed Innocent Life (In case of long-lasting and serious quarrels)

What causes wars, and what causes fightings among you? Is it not your passions that are at war in your members? You desire and do not have; so you kill. And you covet and cannot obtain; so you fight and wage war. You do not have, because you do not ask. You ask and do not receive, because you ask wrongly, to spend it on your passions. Unfaithful creatures! Do you not know that friendship with the world is enmity with God? Therefore whoever wishes to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God. Or do you suppose it is in vain that the scripture says, "He yearns jealously over the spirit which He has made to dwell in us"? But He gives more grace; therefore it says, "God opposes the proud, but gives grace to the humble." Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you. Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners, and purify your

hearts, you men of double mind. Be wretched and mourn and weep. Let your laughter be turned to mourning and your joy to dejection. Humble yourselves before the Lord and He will exalt you. (Jas 4:1-10)

Be merciful, even as your Father is merciful. Judge not, and you will not be judged; condemn not, and you will not be condemned; forgive, and you will be forgiven. (Lk 6:36-37)

Then Peter came up and said to Him, "Lord, how often shall my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? As many as seven times?" Jesus said to him, "I do not say to you seven times, but seventy times seven." (Matt 18:21-22)

Prayer

Good and merciful Heavenly Father, Your Son Jesus Christ teaches me to forgive all offences and to ask forgiveness for the offences I



committed against You and against others. He teaches me to forgive wholeheartedly, including my enemies, because if I do not forgive others, if I do not ask forgiveness, You cannot forgive me either.

Father, thank You for the possibility of forgiving and being forgiven, and for the opportunity of making a new start with You and with others. Thank You for not closing the door when we knock and invoke Your mercy. Blessed and praised are You for the mercy that you have shown me so far, and that You are always ready to show me. Jesus, teach me to for give if I want to receive forgiveness! Strengthen my love, and I will be reconciled with You and with others, and I will be at peace.

Mary, you always call me to peace

and reconciliation. Thus, you call me to forgive and ask forgiveness. Teach me to do what your Son, my Saviour, asks me to do.

Jesus, I admit that I struggle to forgive. That is why I quarrel and live in misunderstanding with You and with others. Because of the refusal of reconciliation, my heart is filled with envy, jealousy, slander, bad words and bad acts. I have offended others and others have offended me. My heart is wounded and I have wounded other people's hearts because I was not ready to forgive. Because of unforgiveness, I spread disorder in my life, in my family, in my community. I suffered a lot and I suffer when a conflict remains. You know how hard it is for me to forgive. That is why, before receiving Your

forgiveness through the priest, I implore You to give me strength to forgive wholeheartedly all those with whom I am not at peace, from whom I am separated by a wall of hatred, envy, jealousy and pride. Give me the strength to approach them and reach out to be reconciled with them.

Forgive me for not taking reconciliation seriously. I found excuses, saying that it was the fault of others, and that they should come to me and seek reconciliation, because they offended me first. I am sorry to see that I was so often led by selfishness and pride, and not by humility and the desire for peace. Please forgive me! Purify my heart from all sinful attachments to people and things. Make me free and I will joyfully and in peace celebrate the power of Your mercy and forgiveness.

I pray for all those whom I have offended. Give them strength to forgive me, so that we can be reconciled. Father, make us similar to You through forgiveness.

I pray for all unreconciled families, where parents do not forgive children, where children are merciless towards their parents. May spouses always have the strength to forgive each other and live together in peace. I pray for all those who are now at risk of divorce because they cannot reconcile. I pray for divorcees, that they may be reconciled. I pray for children of divorced parents, that they may not remain in hatred and the inability to forgive their parents who hate each other, and by their hatred and inability to forgive each other, they hurt their children.

Look on peoples and systems that are unable to find the path to peace because they do not know You and have no strength to forgive. May they all reach out to make peace in our world.

Queen of Peace, Mother of goodness, love and mercy, by your maternal kindness intercede for us, your children, who are unable to reconcile. Mother of the Church, by the power of forgiveness, obtain peace for the whole Church, to all the communities in the Church. Through your intercession, may all Christian churches and all religions be reconciled!

Good Jesus, You have revealed to us the Father's mercy. You have called us to be merciful and to forgive. Reflecting on Your words, I beg You to grant all necessary graces to all. Let PEACE come, let everyone know how to forgive others their trespasses as You want the Father to forgive us through You.

Jesus, I want to forgive and reconcile. Send me Your Holy Spirit. Enlighten me and help me. Amen.
